The Community

The Old Adobe Union School District is located in the city of Petaluma, CA, approximately 30 miles north of San Francisco in the beautiful Sonoma Valley. The community is family oriented with great support for the district as demonstrated in the passage of a \$26 million General Obligation Bond in 2012.

Petaluma is the southern most city in Sonoma County with easy access to San Francisco International, Oakland International and Charles M. Schultz airports. There is a marina with a river connection to San Francisco Bay. The District is a short drive away from the breathtaking Pacific Ocean coast of Northern California.

The heart of Petaluma is it's historic Victorian downtown area where there are over 600 businesses and 65 historic properties. Local opportunities for outdoor activities include biking, kayaking, hiking,



beach activities, and the region is internationally know for its wineries. Santa Rosa Junior College, which serves more than 40,000 students, has a campus in Petaluma.

The District

The Old Adobe School District is a 1700 ADA K-6 district located within the city of Petaluma and the unincorporated areas of Southern Sonoma County. The district has five school sites, with each school offering a unique program focus such as visual and performing arts, music, and language.



OAUSD also provides a unique opportunity for learning with its English/Spanish Dual Immersion program and is developing the only STEM grade school in the county. The district has been a leader in incorporating technology in the curricula and each school has a library/media center. Every campus has a science lab that is funded through a district wide Foundation.

Led by a student focused Board, the district has been on a successful path in recent years and is looking forward to next steps in improving student learning. The district is financially sound and operates with an annual budget of approximately \$12 million.


