Bend-La Pine Schools is located in Deschutes County in the heart of Oregon. The District serves three distinct communities: Bend, Sunriver and La Pine. Nestled at the base of the Cascade Mountain Range, it borders the alpine forest and the high desert.

Deschutes County is one of the fastest-growing counties in the state of Oregon and offers abundant year-round recreational activities. The scenery is breathtaking. Many points of interest lie within the county's boundaries.

Bend is located 130 miles east of Eugene, Oregon, 175 miles southeast of Portland, Oregon, and 131 miles southeast of Salem, Oregon.

Bend, Sunriver and La Pine make up Bend-La Pine Schools which serves a population of more than 17,163 students, kindergarten through grade 12.

La Pine is located 30 miles south of Bend. Four schools: La Pine Elementary, Rosland Elementary, La Pine Middle School and La Pine High School - serve the close-knit community with an enrollment of approximately 1,300 students.

The Sunriver area of the District also includes Fall River and Spring River. Three Rivers School serves students K-8 with an enrollment of over 400 students. Students from this area continue to either Bend or La Pine schools for high school.

Bend is the largest of the communities served by Bend-La Pine Schools. The balance of the enrollment - over 14,000 students - is served in fourteen elementary schools, four middle schools and four high schools.

Bend-La Pine Schools sets high standards to create world class schools by preparing their students for the future. Students at Bend-La Pine Schools earn college credits while still enrolled in high school through College Now, Expanded Options, Advanced Placement, and International Baccalaureate. College Now is where teachers partner with Central Oregon Community College or Oregon Institute of Technology for transfer and technical prep courses in 30 courses. 5,500 college credit hours are earned. Expanded Options is where students take classes at a community college or four-year universities and apply the coursework to their diploma and future degree.

- A current résumé
- A completed application form
- Reference letters, certificates and licenses, and academic transcripts from colleges/universities indicating degree(s)
