Sisseton, South Dakota is located in the northeast corner of the state two miles west of I-29 on U.S. Highway 10. Cities in close proximity to Sisseton include: Aberdeen, SD-90 miles west; Watertown, SD-60 miles south; Fargo, ND-90 miles north and Minneapolis/St. Paul, MN-220 miles to the southeast.

Among the employers for the 2450 residents of Sisseton are the school district and the Sisseton-Wahpeton Sioux Tribe. The city has many businesses including restaurants, grocery store, specialty stores, agricultural related services and products, general merchandise stores, banks, and motels.

The community has 15 churches representing many different denominations.

Medical care is available at the Coteau des Prairies Hospital and Clinic, dentists and other health care professionals are also available. There are also three elder care/assisted living facilities in Sisseton.

Recreational activities are available at the two city parks and the three-pool swimming complex. There are also facilities for golf, tennis and baseball. Outdoor activities in the area include: hunting, fishing, horseback riding, water skiing, sailing, snowmobiling, ice skating, cross country skiing, sledding, ice fishing and hiking.

Some of the community events in Sisseton are Ft. Sisseton Historical Festival & Rendezvous, Sisseton Antique/Classic Car & Motorcycle Show, Hills & Valley Trail Ride, Sisseton Wahpeton Tribe Annual Wacipi (Pow-wow), Horse & Buggy Days, and Ft. Sisseton Frontier Christmas.

Sisseton schools have an enrollment of 925 students in grades Pre-K to 12. Staff includes six administrators, 84 teachers and 88 classified staff. The district covers approximately 850 square miles.

There are three attendance centers in the district. The elementary, middle, and high schools are located in Sisseton. The middle and high schools are located together at the same

facility. High school students are offered honors classes, and they can receive college credits through on line courses.

Both the middle and high schools offer many athletic opportunities. Some of the sports offered are: football, cross country, boys' and girls' golf, boys' and girls' basketball, gymnastics, wrestling, cheerleading, track and volleyball.

Musical groups include: Concert Band, Jazz Band, Pep Club, Mixed Chorus, Swing Singers, and various instrumental and vocal ensembles.



Extracurricular clubs and organizations include: Art Club, Drama Club, Key Club, "S" Club, FBLA, FFA, Knowledge Bowl, National Honor Society, Family Career Community Leaders of America, Student Council, TATU, IMPROV, Oral Interpretation, a number of Athletic Clubs, One-Act Play and annual staff.

Assessed valuation is \$537,180,354 and the general fund budget is \$8,470,219.
