The Ocosta School District is located in Westport, Washington and serves as the hub for an interesting and diverse coastal community. The area known as South Beach is composed of a group of small towns, located between Grays Harbor and Willapa Bay on the Washington coast. The South Beach has a number of outdoor recreational activities, and a landscape of unlimited inspiration. Eighteen miles of sandy beaches stretch along the South Beach. The area is one of the largest most pristine bays in the United States and has a bustling deep water port visited by ships from all over the world. The total year-round population is approximately 7,000.

The city of Westport is just 70 miles west of the state capital in Olympia and 135 miles from Seattle.

The Ocosta School District covers 264 square miles and educates 600 students. There are 96 staff members: 45 certified staff, 51 classified staff, and four administrative.

The Ocosta School District facilities are all located on one campus on the edge of Westport. Ocosta Elementary School, grades P-6 has 311 students. The elementary program includes a locally funded full day Kindergarten and a developmental preschool and ECEAP.

The Junior/Senior High School has 279 students. In addition to the basic education program, students are involved in a variety of specialized offerings such as: Highly Capable, Title I, Transitional Bilingual, Migrant, Indian Education, Running Start, Career and Technical Education, and Advanced Placement.

Extracurricular opportunities include: football, boys and girls basketball, cross country, boys and girls track, wrestling, softball, baseball, volleyball, soccer, band, drama, math team, Future Business Leaders of America, cheer squad and Knowledge Bowl.

All of the teachers in Ocosta meet the highly qualified standard. The curriculum is up-to-date and is research-based. The teachers and the curriculum are focused on student success and developing well

rounded citizens. The Smarter Balance Assessment results are generally at or above the state level.

The assessed valuation of the district is \$695,888,104. The operating budget is \$8,526,262. Traditionally, the district has maintained a strong ending fund balance.

The Board of Directors consists of five board members, each elected to serve four-year terms. The incumbency of the members ranges from 4 months to 18 years.
