The Community

Carlsbad is located in the Chihuahuan Desert of Southeast New Mexico, county seat of Eddy County, centrally located between Albuquerque, NM (275 miles), El Paso, TX (175 miles), Midland, TX (170 miles), and Lubbock, TX (180 miles).

The Carlsbad community of 29,000 residents, is a welcome oasis in the desert of southeastern New Mexico. City parks, pedestrian and bike trails, boating and water sport facilities abound. Two golf courses grace the banks of Lake Carlsbad. Wildlife, lakes and streams invite hunting and fishing. Tourism is of major importance due to national and state parks nearby.

New Mexico State University-Carlsbad offers academic, vocational and continuing educational opportunities. A public library, historical museum and art galleries encourage visitation and exploration.

Carlsbad has an outstanding and very active community theater, two senior recreation centers, multi-event civic center and a convention center. Carlsbad Community Concerts Association invites culture to the community through world-class concert artists.

Carlsbad also boasts a large colony of art enthusiasts and patrons-painters, sculptors, potters, wood and metal artists.

The largest employer is the Waste Isolation Pilot Project; farming and ranching, and production of gas, oil and other natural products are the economic backbone. Two retirement and nursing facilities support a large retirement community, and a full-service hospital is served by a sizeable contingency of physicians and specialists.

Carlsbad is the home to many churches and religious beliefs. In fact, Carlsbad is just a nice place to live and rear a family!

The District

Carlsbad Municipal Schools promotes education and achievement through its sound programs and well-trained staff. Neighborhood schools are small enough to allow site principals to recognize each and every student, and to encourage open communication with parents and patrons.

Carlsbad Municipal Schools is composed of a high school, an early college high school, one intermediate school, one sixth grade academy, six elementary schools



and an Early Child Education Center, one pre-school, one charter school, and one virtual charter school. The current enrollment is 6,410 students. There are 781 staff members which includes 46 administrators, 441 teachers and other professionals and 294 classified staff. The district covers 2,475 square miles.

Advanced placement for secondary students and gifted-talented programs are available. The Career Technical Education Program is an emphasis of the school district to establish certificated vocational/technical programs. The district has a partnership with New Mexico State University at Carlsbad.

Carlsbad graduating seniors routinely garner valuable academic and vocational scholarships for post-secondary training.

The geographic location of the school district offers myriad possibilities for field trips and

studies for students in every grade level, and cultural diversity resides in the richness of the regional history.



The district operating budget is \$161 million with an assessed valuation of \$2,325,663,320.
