The Meade School District encompasses portions of Lawrence and Meade Counties in western South Dakota. The district office is located in Sturgis. Other communities in the district include Whitewood, Fort Meade, Piedmont, Stagebarn, Summerset, Atall, Enning, Elm Springs, Hereford, Opal, and Union Center. Meade County, located in the heart of ranching country, is the largest county in the state covering more than two million acres.

Sturgis is located on I-90 in the northern foothills of the Black Hills. Deadwood is located to the west of Sturgis, and Rapid City is 30 miles to the southeast. The City of Sturgis has approximately 7,000 residents and is known as the "City of Riders."

The Black Hills region offers many recreational and entertainment opportunities. Sturgis attractions include the Sturgis Motorcycle Rally, the Mustang and Camaro Rally, Black Hills National Cemetery, Bear Butte State Park, Fort Meade Cavalry Museum, Sturgis Motorcycle Museum and Hall of Fame, and Wonderland Cave. Sturgis also offers a public golf course, restaurants, and scenic drives through Vanocker Canyon or Boulder Canyon. Mt. Rushmore National Memorial and Custer State Park are within an hour's drive of Sturgis.

Outdoor activities in the area include bicycling, camping, cross country and downhill skiing, fishing, golfing, hiking, horseback riding, hunting, rock climbing, snowmobiling, and water sports.

Sturgis offers churches of all denominations and a variety of medical care facilities.

Higher educational opportunities are available at Black Hills State University—Spearfish, South Dakota School of Mines & Technology—Rapid City, Western Dakota Technical Institute—Rapid City, and National American University—Rapid City.

The District




Meade School District has an approximate enrollment of 2,825 students and covers 3,122 square miles. This district is South Dakota's ninth largest school district for enrollment, and the largest in area. There are 360 staff members in the district, 14 administrators, 207 certified teachers, and 139 classified staff members.

In 2007, Meade School District was the first district in South Dakota to receive district-wide accreditation from North Central Association Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement.

The district's challenging and diverse curriculum includes Advanced Placement courses and dual enrollment courses for college credit, a School-to-Careers internship and award-winning vocational and career preparation programs.

Students can participate in many extracurricular activities. Some of the sports offered are: football, basketball, volleyball, wrestling, tennis, track, golf, cross country, soccer, cheerleading, and dance. Non-sport activities

include drama, speech, debate, FFA, Knowledge Bowl, choir, band, FCCLA, YLT, and journalism.

- Reference letters, certificates and licenses, and academic transcripts from colleges/universities indicating degree(s).
