- Who is consistent in relationships with staff, capable of establishing an environment of individual accountability, and is a thoughtful/decisive decision maker (capability of making practical decisions and utilizes "common sense").
- Who is visible, values community involvement, will commit to Foreman, assumes ownership of the District, and capable of motivating others to follow.
- Who is a visionary leader that understands and can influence teaching/learning positively, values instruction, and still maintains the balance between curricular and extra-curricular programs.
- Who understands the application of school finance and the Arkansas Public School Funding Formula, capable of leading a millage campaign, and will maintain an awareness and understanding of the needs of maintaining the school plant, equipment, and facilities.

Foreman, Arkansas is located near the Arkansas-Texas border, 30 miles from I-30. The city of 1,025 residents cities is near Horatio, Ashdown, and DeQueen, Arkansas; and New Boston, Texas.

The District

Foreman School District educates 509 students on two campuses, Oscar Hamilton Elementary and Foreman High School. The 101-square mile district has 78 staff members, 3 administrators, 42 certified teachers, and 33 classified staff.

Foreman offers a Gifted and Talented program, National Honor Society, Quiz Bowl, and Concurrent Classes. They have a partnership with Cossatot Community College of the University of Arkansas; Southern Arkansas University; Education Renewal Zone; and member of North Central Association.

Extracurricular activities through the district include football, basketball, baseball, softball, golf, track, cheerleading, drama club, key club, FBLA, FCCLA, FFA, First Priority Club, and band.

- A completed application form
- Reference letters, certificates and licenses, and academic transcripts from colleges/universities indicating degree(s)
