Ogden is located on US Highway 30 about 25 miles west of Interstate 35 and Ames, and about 45 miles northwest of Des Moines.

Major employers in the city of 2,044 residents include Ogden Community School District; AgReliant; Northern Natural Gas; Fareway Stores, Inc,; Union Pacific; and John Deere Manufacturing.

Ogden Community School District covers 144 square miles and serves 700 students. The district has 4 administrators, 60 certificated teachers, and 54

- Reference letters, certificates and licenses, and academic transcripts from colleges/universities indicating degree(s)
