The Position

The Webster City Community School District, Webster City, Iowa, Board of Directors, is seeking a highly qualified superintendent of schools. The Board wishes to have the successful candidate assume the responsibilities of the position on July 1, 2018.

The Qualifications

- **Visionary Innovator** This leader must have the ability to think strategically and critically, is a lifelong learner, dedicated to "team", and champions the internal district culture.
 - **Visibility** Engaged within the district and with the external community and is supportive of all school and non-school activities.

The Community

Webster City is located in northern Iowa, within an hour of Cedar Falls, Ames, and Des Moines.

The active city of 8,070 residents hosts many events including Junque Fest; Festival of Chocolate; Ladies Night Out; Music in the Park; Arts are Alive; and Legacy Learning.

Custom Meats, Mary Ann's Specialty Foods, Seneca Foundry, Tasler's Inc., Van Diest Supply Company, Van Diest Medical Center and Van Tec are the major employers in the area. Vera Blue Farms and Prestige Farms have recently opened businesses in the city.

Medical care is available from Van Diest Medical Center and Clinic; and McFarland Clinic in Webster City. Additional care facilities are McFarland Clinic and Mary Greeley Medical Center in Ames.

Residents can enjoy a variety of indoor and outdoor activities in the area. Outdoor venues include Fuller Hall Outdoor Pool; Briggs Woods Park, Trail, and Golf Course; Webster City Links Golf Course; Brewer Creek Trail; Kendall Young Park; Boone River; Nokomis Park/Middleton Sports Complex; and Wilson Brewer Park. Other recreational



venues are Fuller Hall Recreation Facility; Kendall Young Library; Webster City Community Theatre; and Hamilton County Racetrack.

The local colleges and universities offer many spectator sports for the region.

Higher educational opportunities are available from Iowa State University; University of Northern Iowa; Ellsworth Community College; Iowa Central Community College; and North Iowa Area Community College.

Webster City Community School District educates 1,506 students in five school buildings, Pleasant View Elementary (grades PK-1); Sunset Heights Elementary (grades 2-4); Middle School (grades 5-8); High School (grades 9-12); and Hamilton High Alternative High School (grades 10-12). Whole Grade Sharing

agreements are in place for students in grades 7-12 with Stratford and Northeast Hamilton Community School Districts.

Students in the district can

participate in various special programs, TAG is available for students starting in the 3rd grade. Student Council, Club Life, Spanish Club, Lego League, WC Rocketry/TARC, Lynx Leaders, Student Senate, and Lynx Ambassadors are a few of the activities and clubs available to the students. High school students

run a broadcast school channel, WCTV.

Sports and extra curricular activities in the district include cross country, football, volleyball,



basketball, wrestling, track, tennis, softball, baseball, soccer, drama, speech, band, and chorus.

The district has a partnership with Iowa Central Community College for Dual Credit Classes. There is also a partnership with the Regional Career Academy. The district is in the initial stages of creating a Regional Ag Academy.



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The assessed valuation for the district is \$442,916,363. The operating budget is \$19.5M.
