The District

West Branch CSD has an enrollment of 844 students and covers 123 square miles. There are 130 staff members, 4 administrators, 71 certified teachers, and 55 classified staff members.

The district has three school buildings, elementary school, middle school, and a high school. A new ACE Building was just constructed on the high school campus.

Special programs available to the students include Leader In Me, Learning Strategies Program, volunteering, and AP classes. The district has a partnership with Kirkwood for some classes as well. Students can participate in many sports, including football, basketball, volleyball, track, baseball, softball, wrestling, golf and the District is in its first year of offering soccer. Tennis and cross country are shared with Iowa City Schools. There is strong music program that includes Show Choir and Jazz Band. The drama department also has many student participants.

The assessed valuation of the district is \$356,935,094. The operating budget is \$11,580,992.



Board of Education

The Board of Education consists of five members who are elected to serve four-year terms. The incumbency of the Board members range from one to three years.
