The Position

The Valdez City Schools, Valdez, Alaska Board of Education, is seeking a highly qualified and fully certified Superintendent. The Board wishes to have the successful candidate assume the responsibilities of the position on or before July 1, 2022.

The Qualifications

The candidate must have the background, skills, and abilities essential for excellence in educational leadership. The board recognizes that selecting a superintendent is one of the most important decisions it will make. The board has identified the following desired characteristics:

- Possess strong leadership skills and management skills with a respect for the opinions of others to establish a good working relationship and focus on excellence with students, staff members, district patrons and the Board of Education. Be a visible and active participant in the school and community.
- Well versed in quality educational ideals. Has the ability to create a climate for strong educational values. Have a proven track record on successful implementation of effective educational programs.
- Possesses excellent interpersonal relationship and public relationship skills. Has the ability to work effectively with all stakeholders, listening to all, while maintaining the focus of the district.
- Has the ability to identify strengths of others and build upon those strengths and develop collaborative relationships. A positive team builder with ability to delegate and create a climate for positive risk-taking.

The Community

Valdez, Alaska is situated at the beginning of the Richardson Highway. With an active harbor and airport, Valdez is accessible by land, air, or water. Fairbanks is 365 miles to the north, and Anchorage is 300 land miles to the west.

The town and the surrounding area boast spectacular scenery and diverse wildlife. Its location makes it ideal for fishing, kayaking, sailing, hiking, skiing, ice climbing, hunting, and snowmobiling. Its sound tax base provides library, swimming pool, community college, and gyms. Community, college, and school groups share the Civic Center Theater with weekend movies, and events like the Last Frontier Theater Conference, Gold Rush Days, Silver Salmon Derby Kick Offs, Ducks Unlimited and other banquets, and oil transportation industry meetings share the ballroom and meeting rooms.

The largest employers in this city of 4,000 residents include Alyeska Pipeline Service Company, Providence Medical Center, City of Valdez/Valdez City Schools, and the Coast Guard. Both commercial and sport fishing are important in the summer. Locals are also employed in other tourism pursuits in the summer and increasingly in the winter.

Higher educational opportunities are available from Prince William Sound College, which offers several associate level degrees, certificates, and continuing education opportunities.

- Used its previous investment in technology to quickly transition to devices and internet connections for every child during the COVID shutdown. Has been in continuous full-time brick and mortar school this fall with online back up for quarantined students and staff.
