THE DISTRICT

Maquoketa Community School District is a PK3-12 district serving 1366 students in an approximately 172 square mile area. The district has 4 school buildings: Cardinal Elementary (PK-2), Briggs Elementary (3-5), Maquoketa Middle School (6-8), and Maquoketa High School. The district has an exceptional staff of 12 administrators/ department heads, 132 certified teachers, and 110 classified staff members. The district has an assessed valuation of \$450.4 million, an \$18 million general fund operation budget with an overall budget of \$26 million.

Maquoketa Community School District provides many opportunities for student success. There are plenty of STEM opportunities available. Some special programs for students include the Talented and Gifted Programs, and Lighthouse Teams. Clinton Community College has a Maquoketa Campus located right next to Maquoketa High School and partners with the district for vast course offerings.

The students are the heart of the district. There are many athletics, arts, and extracurricular activities available for them. We are proud of the number of students who graduate with associates degrees, welding certificates, and CNAs. We have a Commitment to Leader in Me & Professional Learning Committees, and instructional coaches are available in every building.

- Reference letters, certificates and licenses, and academic transcripts from colleges/universities indicating degree(s).
