The Community

Wilber, Nebraska is the county seat of Saline County, 36 miles southwest of Lincoln. The thriving community has 1,960 residents.

The town has many businesses and civic organizations, Catholic and protestant churches, Czech museum, library, medical facilities, and an optometrist office. A hospital is located 10 miles away in Crete, Nebraska. Crete is the home of Doane College.



The area has a variety of camping and recreational facilities, including: boating, bowling, fishing, golf, hunting, swimming, tennis, theaters, and trap shooting.

In early August, Wilber is home to the Annual Czech Festival. Activities include a parade, Czech craft and food demonstrations, National Czech-Slovak queen competition, polka bands, dancing, and Czech meals.

The District

The Wilber-Clatonia Public Schools, District No. 82, encompasses 207 square miles in Saline, Gage, and Lancaster counties. The district has 604 students enrolled.

Staff includes five administrators, 47 teachers and 39 classified staff. Students attend classes on a centralized campus in one of three interconnected buildings. The PK-5 Elementary building which was completed in 2003, 6-12 Secondary building which was completed in 1970, or the Zoubek Ag Science building which was completed in 2020.

Boys and girls activity programs are members of the Southern Nebraska Conference and are classified C1 and C2 by the Nebraska School Activities Association (NSAA). Extracurricular activities include football, volleyball, cross-country, softball, girls tennis, boys basketball, girls basketball, girls wrestling, boy wrestling, boys track, girls track, speech, play production, instrumental music, vocal music, yearbook, and student council.

Students can obtain college credit through the dual enrollment program with Southeast Community College. Vocational Technology credits are available through the Career Academy at ESU 6.

The assessed valuation for the district is \$754,291,934. The operating budget is \$11,650,290.
