The Position

A leader who will listen to the staff while shaping a curriculum focus. An educator who works toward meeting the needs of all students.
- **Communication:** A leader who listens to everyone impacted by a decision before deciding. A person who is willing to be the "Face" of the district. A person who wants to be present in the Norwood community. A person who writes, speaks, and reads on a professional level. A person who values the presence of others.
- Innovator: A person who thinks outside of the box. A leader who loves research and will keep what is working and build a system of improvement throughout the district. A leader who treasures diversity as a base for learning.

The Community

Nestled atop Wright's Mesa at 7,000 feet, Norwood has spectacular vistas of high alpine and wild desert country. Far horizons are ringed by the La Sal Mountains in the west, the Uncompander Plateau to the north, the San Juan Mountains in the east, and to the south is Norwood's own jewel, Lone Cone Peak. Rugged desert canyons etch the landscape between.

Recreational opportunities are abundant in our area including hunting, fly fishing, hiking, camping, biking, and horseback riding. Norwood is also the first International Dark-Sky Association "Dark Sky Community" on the Western Slope of Colorado and the second Dark Sky Community in Colorado. Norwood is now part of 22 International Dark Sky Communities around the world, 15 of which are in the U.S., with others being in Canada, Denmark, Germany, Scotland, and the U.K.

The District

Norwood Public Schools is a small, rural district with 193 students located in a small ranching community 30 miles west of Telluride, Colorado. We serve the western San Miguel and southeastern Montrose Counties. Norwood School District exceeds expectations in the areas of graduation rate with a rate of 100 percent using a four-year graduation rate.

In addition to our challenging curriculum, our schools offer comprehensive art, physical education, and distance learning courses, both secondary and college level.

In 2018, 2019, and 2023 Norwood Public S c h o o l s w a s a w a r d e d t h e "Accreditation with Distinction" rating by the Colorado State Accountability Report. This is the highest rating from the Colorado Department of Education.

We have a four-day school week, FFA Program, Primetime Preschool Facility, Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports/Multi-Tiered Systems of Support, and House System.
