

For recreation the town has a swimming pool, tennis courts, a nine-hole golf course and a public library. Harlan County Reservoir also provides many recreational activities including fishing. Every summer there is a family friendly and fun county fair.

The District

The Franklin School District has 287 students, 3 administrators, 30 certified staff, and 27 classified staff. The district encompasses 289 square miles in Franklin County and 17 miles in Harlan County. The State of Nebraska and the NCA accredits the district.

FPS enjoys tremendous support from the communities of Macon, Riverton, Bloomington, Naponee, and Franklin that all make up the school district. Franklin is considered a leader in educational programming with numerous college credit courses, award winning speech, FFA, FCCLA, and Skills USA, E-Sports, One-Acts, Quiz Bowl and Future Problem Solvers. Flyer athletics include cross country, football, volleyball, basketball, boys and girls wrestling, track, and golf. The Flyer extracurricular activities have been successful throughout the years and look forward to more outstanding accomplishments.

All PK-12 classrooms have new SmartBoard technology. The facility is air-conditioned and very well maintained. FPS has a greenhouse, two beautiful gyms, a wrestling deck, suburb track/football field along with the weight room.

In conjunction with Franklin County HeadStart, FPS provides a preschool on campus.

In their 2024 list, *US News* ranked Franklin Elementary School as the 23rd best elementary school in the State of Nebraska.

In 2008, Franklin Public Schools was recognized by the United States Department of Education with their "Blue Ribbon of Excellence" award. The President and Congress's education initiatives have stressed accountability for results for all students. The No Child Left Behind--Blue Ribbon Schools Program honors elementary and secondary schools that make significant progress in closing the achievement gap or whose students achieve at the highest levels.

We qualified because our student achievement scores are in the top 10% and because they have seen great improvement over the past five years. Only 24 schools in Nebraska have received this distinction in the past decade! Our students, staff, and community are very deserving of this great honor from the United States Department of Education.

The 2024-25 total budget is \$7,471,208. The current assessed valuation is \$523,934,798.

- Reference letters, certificates and licenses, and academic transcripts from colleges/universities indicating degree(s).
